School Update following the Prime Minister's address to the Nation

Monday 11 May 2020

Dear Parents/Carers

Yesterday evening I, like I am sure many of you, listened to the Prime Minister's address to the nation. I am also certain that it has generated a raft of questions that you need answering. It has for schools also.

Today and in the coming days we are expecting a more detailed plan and more guidance about how to move forward. The government through the Department for Education (DfE), the Nottinghamshire Local Authority, unions and school leaders will be discussing how to achieve what the government want whilst ensuring that schools remain safe places for our children and staff. As soon as this guidance comes and we have applied it to our own local context at Brinsley Primary and Nursery School, we will inform you - our school community.

At the moment, all we know is that "if the conditions are right schools will reopen to Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 on June 1."

In the meantime and until we are told otherwise schools remain open to the children of key workers and 'vulnerable' children (as defined [here](#)) only. Nothing has changed – Schools will continue to run for these children on a skeleton staff, ensuring there is appropriate safety measures in place.

I am sorry I cannot tell you more at this point, but rest assured as soon as I can, I will.
