Expression of interest - “Keeping in Touch” opportunity

Dear Parents/Carers

Many of you will have made a decision in recent weeks about your child/ren returning to school. Some of you will have decided yes, others will have decided that it was not the right time. However, there are also a considerable number of parents and children for whom there has not been this choice. Additionally, there are parents who initially opted not to send their children in who would perhaps like the opportunity to reconsider at some point.

Currently there is no way we can fit everyone back in school, or bring back Years 2, 3, 4 and 5; As of next week, every classroom in school will have a ‘bubble’ occupying it.

HOWEVER WE HAVE A PLAN.

If the children who are currently in school, were to finish a week or two before the end of term (last day of school is currently Friday 24 July 2020), following a thorough deep clean, we could then give access to those children that have been ‘disconnected’ from their school and their friends for such a long time.

The purpose of this “Keeping in Touch” opportunity would not be to catch up on learning, or to do any transition in preparation for September – this will probably happen at the beginning of the next academic year (more information to follow). It would be solely to reconnect to their friends, to play, laugh and smile – all in the familiar surroundings of school; to finish the year on a positive note before the Summer holidays.

Please note that Key Worker/Vulnerable children provision will continue to be provided until 24/07/20 for all those who need it.

Accompanying this letter will be a survey. It will be sent to everyone and will be asking your views on this idea. In order to plan anything definitively, we need to know what demand there is and how many children there may be onsite. Until we know this, we cannot give any more detail, nor can we say how long this “keeping in touch” opportunity may be for.
