Paper	Muddy Puddle Teacher Home Learning ideas – Send any selfies or pictures to Class Dojo
Online	Dojo – Various activities and web links will be added on a regular basis.
Handwriting	Continue to practise writing your name and letter formation. (Previously sent)
Reading books	The children have been given additional reading books to share at home.
Phonics	Continue with the phonemes we have been learning using the phonic cards previously sent home to practise making words. (s, a, t, p) We have sent some extras that we have learnt in the last few weeks (i, n, m)
